REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. For Non-Christians: What assumptions have you made about Jesus, and how does the story of the paralytic in Mark 2:1–12 challenge you to explore his claims about himself?
2. For Believers: How does the story of Jesus forgiving and healing the paralytic in Mark 2:1–12 deepen your understanding of him as both a compassionate man and God? How does the assurance, "Son, your sins are forgiven," impact your daily life, especially when you face difficulties or feel like God is distant? How can we remind each other of this truth?
3. For the witness of the church:
 - a. How does Jesus's compassionate response to the paralytic challenge our societal attitudes toward people with disabilities or those perceived as "less productive"? How can our church better reflect Jesus's compassion in these areas?
 - b. Can you share a time when you or someone you know went to great lengths to bring someone closer to Jesus? What obstacles in Singapore make this challenging, and how can we overcome them?
 - c. Who in your life needs to encounter Jesus, and what practical steps can you take to "lower them through the roof" to him? How can we as a church support each other in this mission?
