INTRODUCTION

- I. The heroes of faith in Hebrews 11 lived out their faith through their actions that demonstrated their belief in the promise of God (Hebrews 11:1-2, 17-40)
- II. The heroes of faith in Hebrews 11 lived as pilgrims and sojourners, and were all commended by GOD for their faith, yet none of them received what was promised in their lifetime (Hebrews 11:13-16, 39-40)

Implications for the individual believer and church today

- III. Living by faith, *not* by sight, underscores our confidence to believe that God rewards those who seek him with full-hearted faith. (Hebrews 11:1, 6)
- IV. Living by faith, *not* by sight, challenges us to live differentiated lives that honour God as an individual believer and together as a body of Christ, the church. (Hebrews 11, John 17:13-19; 1 Peter 2:9-12; Matthew 5:13-16)
 - Differentiated in Character: Distinct – Set apart (sanctified) for the Lord's use.
 - Differentiated in Conduct: Distinct to live out the purposes of God through who we are as a people of God.

1. What might living by faith, *not* by sight, means for me, given a culture where success is measured by possessions, prestige, & position in life?
2. What might “differentiated in character and in conduct” means for me
 - as a believer within the body of Christ (church), and
 - living among many people of other faiths in the context of modern-day Singapore?

Together, as a church celebrating its 48th Anniversary, what might living by faith, *not* by sight, mean for us, the body of Christ, especially when we read 1 Peter 2 & Matthew 5?
